III. Documentation of Insurance

Include images of the following system components: solar collector(s), storage tank and heat exchanger, and control(s) and circulator(s).

Provide REV with proof that a company employee has successfully completed an Institute for Sustainable Power, Inc. (ISPQ)–accredited solar hot water training program within the last year. If no ISPQ-accredited courses are available, another REV-approved course would be acceptable.

Provide the VT plumbing license number of at least one company employee (a Type S specialty license is sufficient) and proof that the employee who holds the license has completed a REV-approved solar thermal training course within the last year.
